

# Fairtrade Guernsey Schools' Competition 2022



Fairtrade Fortnight 2022 is from 21<sup>st</sup> Feb – 6<sup>th</sup> March

This year's challenge is to design a Fairtrade, re-usable travel tea / coffee cup. The cups will be made from rice husk, contain NO plastic and are biodegradable.

The design should be bright, bold and original and needs to promote Guernsey as a Fairtrade island and reflect Fairtrade principles. The artwork can be digital or you can use felt tips or coloured pencils – you must use the template supplied. The 2 winners will have their designs printed onto cups which will be sold to Fairtrade supporters and used at Fairtrade events.

The competition will be split into the following 2 age categories:

1. Primary Year R – Year 6
2. Secondary Year 7 – Year 11

The closing date for the competition is Friday 11<sup>th</sup> March 2022. Designers need to put their name, school and age on the front of their entries or in the file name, if sending digitally. Entries can be submitted through your school or directly, either by emailing them to [info@fairtradeguernsey.com](mailto:info@fairtradeguernsey.com) or putting them in the competition entry box in the children's library. Winners will be announced by the end of March 2022.
